Giotto ~~was~~ famous in a Florentine painter.

Sienese art went on for two centuries.

Duccio depicted the New Testament in the Byzantine tradition, with ~~some~~ varied color.

In the next generation, Martini used outlines, and with Lorenzetti followed Duccio, court artist, and the artist of the Pisa polyptych, in 1320.
